The City of Berkeley will be renovating the Tennis and Basketball Courts at Grove Park. Renovation includes the reconstruction of the tennis courts, resurfacing at the basketball courts, and improvement of the pathways and amenities to allow for better drainage and accessibility of the park.*

LOCATION: 2828 Martin Luther King, Jr. Way, between Oregon Street and Russell Street, area outlined in blue on map below.

TIMELINE: Construction is expected to begin in July 2016 and take about 5 months to complete depending on weather or unforeseen conditions. Standard work hours are 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday, barring any unforeseen conditions. RESIDENT and PROPERTY OWNER ACTIONS: No interruptions in sewer, water, electric, gas, or phone service are anticipated.

POSSIBLE INCONVENIENCES: "No Parking" signs will be posted along the street at least 3 days in advance of construction and will be enforced by the Police Department. Parking will be restricted to allow for construction access and vehicle movement. Please see the posted signs for exact hours and locations as they may vary according to scheduled tasks. All other usual parking restrictions, including no parking for street cleaning, will still be in effect. Traffic may be delayed at the worksite to allow for construction vehicle movement, but the street will not be closed, except under unforeseen circumstances. Access to private driveways will be maintained. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
