The City of Berkeley Rose Garden Trellis Rehabilitation project will be underway. Work in this first phase includes the documentation and demolition of the existing Trellis, reconstruction of the center portion of the trellis, and accessibility improvements to the path of travel, including lighting from Codornices Park to the Rose Garden. This project is vital to the safety of park users.

LOCATION: 1201 Euclid Avenue, between Eunice Street and Bayview Place

TIMELINE: Construction is expected to begin in June 2016 and take about 4 months to complete depending on weather or unforeseen conditions. Standard work hours are 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday, barring any unforeseen conditions. Schedule updates will be available on the City’s website at:


RESIDENT and PROPERTY OWNER ACTIONS: No interruptions in sewer, water, gas, electric, or phone service are anticipated. Access to the park may be limited.

- Safety: Keep children and pets away from work area
- Sensitive to Petroleum: Be aware that asphalt paving will not be used in this project

POSSIBLE INCONVENIENCES: "No Parking" signs will be posted along the street at least 3 days in advance of construction and will be enforced by the Police Department. Parking will be restricted to allow for construction access and vehicle movement.

Please see the posted signs for exact hours and locations as they may vary according to scheduled tasks. All other usual parking restrictions, including no parking for street cleaning, will still be in effect. Traffic may be delayed at the worksite to allow for construction vehicle movement, but the street will not be closed, except under unforeseen circumstances. Access to private driveways will be maintained.

Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
