



Summit Reservoir and Shasta Pumping Plant Replacement Update


Dear Neighbors,

EBMUD is replacing the 37 Million Gallon Summit Reservoir, built in 1898, and replacing it with a 3.5 Million Gallon partially buried tank. EBMUD is also building a new pumping plant to replace the current outdated plant. EBMUD will landscape the site and add a walking path along Grizzly Peak at the end of the project. This project is scheduled to be completed in mid-2017.

EBMUD's contractor has completed the temporary tank that will serve the area while the new tank is being built. EBMUD's water quality department is testing the tank before putting it in use later this month. EBMUD's contractor could begin demolition of the old reservoir as early as November 2, 2015. Equipment will be arriving on site in late October. Demolition is expected to be complete in February of 2016. You will see increased activity, noise and construction traffic around the site. Truck hauling of debris could begin as early as mid-November. Flaggers will be deployed during trucking operations and you can expect slower than usual traffic on Spruce.

Standard Work hours are Monday through Friday 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. Activities greater than 90db at the property line will be restricted between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm.
