SPECIAL NOTICE: RESTRICTED TRAFFIC FLOW



PROJECT:

The City of Berkeley has hired O. C. Jones & Sons to rehabilitate the paving of the Berkeley Transfer Station (bounded by Codornices Creek and Gilman Street, and by 2nd Street and the Railroad line). The Contractor will be using a method that recycles and strengthens much of the existing surface. This method is called Full-Depth Reclamation (FDR) and will take place from the afternoon of Friday September 30, 2016 through the morning of Monday, October 3, 2016.

Construction in your immediate vicinity may not extend for this entire period. Work hours will be 6:00 p.m. Friday afternoon - 4:00 a.m. Monday morning. Please be advised that dates are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances outside of the City's control.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS: Traffic should not be seriously impacted along the City streets.

OTHER ADVISORIES:

- The Contractor will implement dust control measures, but please be advised that dust cannot be completely eliminated.
- There may be some construction related noise during the night(s) of work.
- Persons sensitive to petroleum products should be aware that asphalt will be used in this project.
