Subject: **Berkeley Tuolumne Camp Tour and Volunteer Tree Planting Opportunity**

On Saturday, May 15th, 10 am - 2 pm, a tree planting effort will take place at Berkeley Tuolumne Camp on Hardin Flat Road in Groveland, California. The City has secured 1,000 tree seedlings from the Tuolumne River Trust for planting at Berkeley Tuolumne Camp. Up to 50 volunteers can attend to plant trees at Camp, and City staff will offer small group tours of the Camp construction site. City staff is conducting outreach to community groups who may have had limited opportunities to attend Berkeley Tuolumne Camp. The City will provide lunch and a gas voucher for those unable to pay for transportation (see attached flyer).

This is a one-day event. Space is limited and there will be no formal in-person presentations or speeches in order to ensure compliance with proper COVID safety protocols. Councilmembers and Commissioners are invited to attend.
