Re: Public Input on Vision 2050 Program Plan

This memo provides a brief update on the public process for Vision 2050 and requests input on the draft Program Plan available at http://www.BerkeleyVision2050.org. The plan is open for public input through Thursday, May 12, 2022, and a revised draft will be presented at the City Council meeting on May 31, 2022.

BACKGROUND

Prior memos dated October 4, 2021, December 13, 2021, and March 28, 2022 have explained the public engagement and outreach process for Vision 2050 implementation and exploration of an infrastructure-focused revenue measure or measures for the November 8, 2022 ballot.

Staff presented, answered questions, and sought public input at four large area public meetings conducted on March 30, April 6, April 13, and April 20. Staff have incorporated the input received to date into a first draft of the Vision 2050 Program Plan available at http://www.BerkeleyVision2050.org. Public input is sought through Thursday, May 12th, at 5:00 pm.
